

WGS SYSTEMS CONFLICT MINERALS DECLARATION

WGS is aware of the impact that minerals found in consumer and commercial based electronics have in financing conflict in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and adjoining countries as defined by the Secretary of State.

The current “Conflict Minerals Law” dictates supply chain due diligence and public disclosure related to the source of these minerals. WGS is committed to fulfilling this regulation in support of our customers who are required to comply with the act and plans to abide by requirements to facilitate the description of WGS products as being “DRC Conflict Free”.

WGS works with our primary suppliers which procure these metals, to express our concern about this issue and request documentation validating their efforts to ensure the materials they purchase from their supply chain are “conflict free”. WGS’s primary suppliers have documented their efforts of addressing the issue of conflict minerals, and WGS is committed to assisting their efforts to maintain compliance with the requirements.

With this understanding, WGS has investigated the primary suppliers and have determined, to the best of our ability, that no materials purchased have originated in the DRC.

WGS shall continue to monitor our primary suppliers to assure that they and their suppliers continue to use DRC conflict free minerals.
